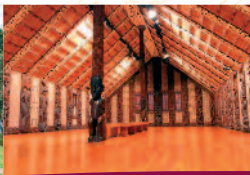


# *Nau Mai, Haere Mai* *Welcome to our Birthplace*

**THE WAITANGI TREATY GROUNDS** is New Zealand's most historic site where, in 1840, Maori Chiefs and the British Crown signed New Zealand's most significant document - *The Treaty of Waitangi*.

The immaculate Treaty Grounds feature abundant native bird life, heritage gardens, bush tracks and stunning sea views of the Bay of Islands.

This unique and distinctive location is of iconic historical and cultural significance and a 'must see' when visiting Northland.

## *Cultural Performances*

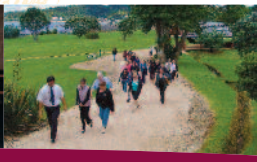
We offer a series of 30-minute Maori cultural performances by our resident group. Be entertained and informed on a journey in traditional and contemporary song.
